

Check Factory Visual Series - Check Format Designer

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How to Modify your Check Format

Open File Menu, Form Control Master.

Choose the Form you wish to modify by clicking on the Form ID lookup button.

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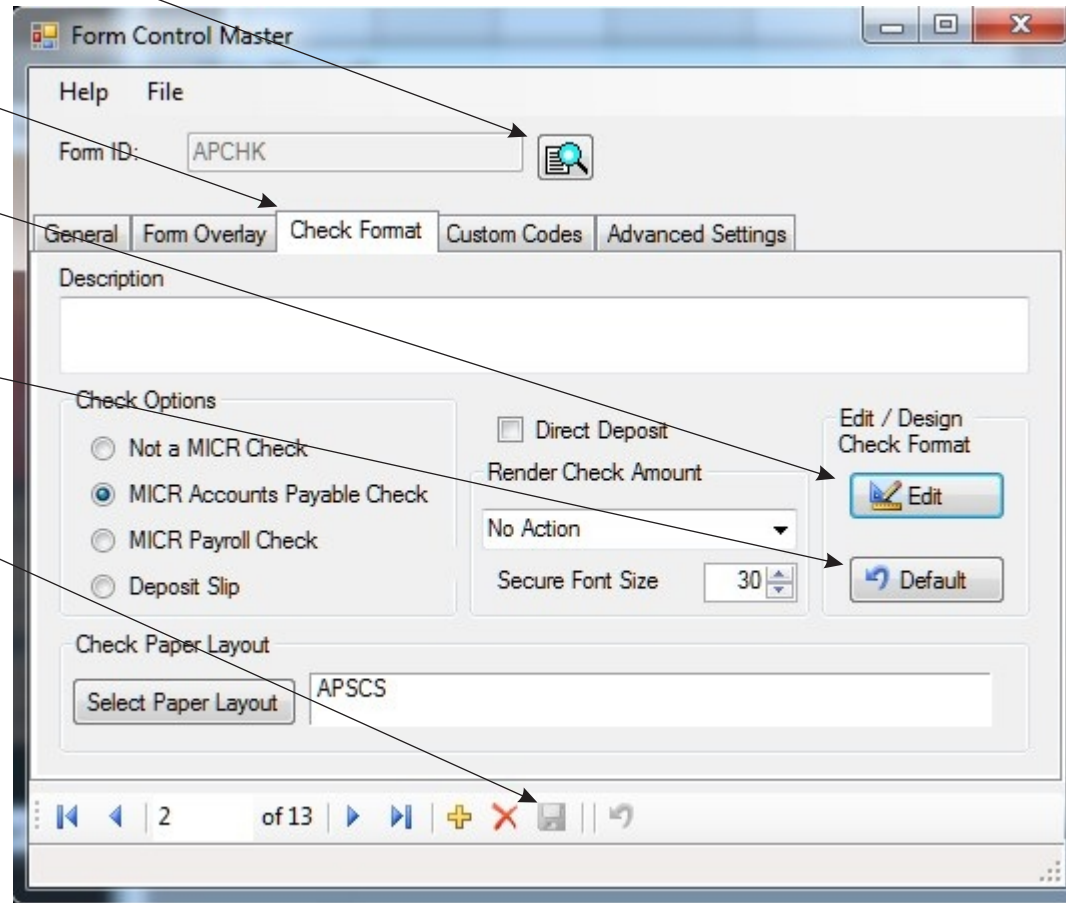
Click on the Check Format Tab.

Click on Edit / Design Check Format.

See the next page for details on how to use the Check Format Designer.

If you are not happy with your changes click on Default to revert the design to defaults.

Press the **Save Button** to save all changes.



How to modify the format:

The light blue rectangles determine the positions of the items on the page. Simply drag the object to the desired position. If you do not want the object to print just delete it. Please note: Changes made here will affect all checks for all companies for this Form ID. Fonts and Text Alignment can be changed if the object has not been modified in a Designer.

Account Name from the Checking Account Control record text box. Font size and alignment changes are allowed.

Account Name, Bank Name, Fractional Routing Code from the Checking Account Control Record - Text box or Account Name Design Object. Font size and alignment changes will only apply if the object has not been modified in a designer. The object will scale up and down in size by changing the width of this object.

MICR Clear Band Area: Nothing is allowed to be printed in this area except the MICR codes.

Account Name from the Checking Account Control record text box. Font size and alignment changes are allowed.

Check Format Designer

Drawing Tools

The drawing tools allow you to draw objects on the drawing surface. To use an object simply click on the object then drag the mouse across the drawing surface holding the left mouse button down.

When Adding an **Image Object** you will be prompted to select an image file once you release the mouse button. Image Objects are for adding Logos, Graphics and Signature images.
